- utility bill management.



Raw building and energy systems data

According to the Verdantix report, Siemens scored higher than any other supplier for its ability to capture both raw building data and energy systems data. Navigator also earned best-in-class capabilities for integrating building automation and control systems.

Energy procurement and risk management

Navigator scored the second highest among suppliers (2.9 out of 3.0) for its energy procurement and risk management capabilities. The Verdantix report cited its ability to manage procurement processes, perform cost and tariff analysis, and conduct procurement scenario planning. Navigator received best-in-class scores for all three of these capabilities.

Utility bill management

The Verdantix report ranked Navigator as the second highest in managing utility bills and invoices.
