

Installation Instructions for a  
replacement Adaptor Plate




**This kit is intended for the installation of a replacement Adaptor Plate for a Type BL / BQD / ED / GB / GB2 breaker in a Siemens P3 Panelboard.**

**KIT INCLUDES: Qty. (1) Adaptor Plate (p/n: 11-D-3033-01) & Qty. (2) mounting screws**

1. **Lock off ALL power supplying this equipment before working on it.**
2. Ensure Type BL / BQD / ED / GB / GB2 breaker is properly installed below where this Adaptor Plate will be mounted.
3. Locate the Adaptor Plate onto the deadfront rail with the two Adaptor Plate holes lining up with the rail holes such that the Adaptor Plate covers the same unit space as its breaker.  
(NOTE: The Adaptor Plate has a slight offset bend close to the mounting holes. Install so that the mounting hole portion is higher than the part that sits over the breaker.)
4. Insert the two screws (included) and tighten until the Adaptor Plate is securely on the rail.
5. Ensure that the Adaptor Plate restricts access to all live parts below the plate. If there is not a 3-pole breaker installed in this location, use one to three DFFP1 fillers (sold separately) to fully close the opening.
6. **Before energizing the panel**, ensure that any barriers and fillers are in place and secure, that the deadfront is installed, that the trim is in place, and the door is closed and locked.
