Description

The SIPROTEC 7SD503 line differential protection is a fast and selective differential protection unit for cables and overhead lines. It is the successor of the 7SD74 static differential protection and works with it when external pilot-wire monitoring is used.

The connection between two 7SD503 units is made via three pilot wires, i.e., existing pilot-wire connections can be used.

The relay can be connected directly to the secondary 1 A or 5 A CT current outputs. A summation CT integrated in the housing of the unit transforms a 100 mA summated current output, which is the comparison quantity. Minimum current transformer requirements due to the integrated saturation detector are considered. Differential protection can be combined with an overcurrent release. Distances up to 5 km can be spanned via 3 pilot wires (protection cable).

As an option, the relay features a pilot-wire supervision and intertrip facility.

The 2nd harmonic remains stable due to inrush of transformers in the protection zone.

The serial PC port (interface) and the numerical keys for convenient relay setting are located on the front part of the unit as are the 8 LEDs serving for local indication and the switch for crossing the pilot-wire connection.

Function overview

Differential protection relay for overhead lines and cables:

- Current differential protection with integrated summation current transformer. Output current under nominal conditions 100 mA
- Pilot-wire monitoring function (option)
- Intertrip facility (option)
- Two-stage definite-time overcurrent protection as backup function based on the summated current
- Overload protection based on the summated current
- Applicable for three terminal lines with 2 relays at each line end

Features

- 100 % protection against all types of short-circuit within the protection zone
- Sensitivity to single-phase faults below rated current
- Fully digital acquisition of the summated current behind the summation current transformer and of currents via the 3 pilot wires
- Software-controlled adaptation of the sensitivity of the differential protection to different wire resistances. This makes pilot-wire trimming unnecessary

Monitoring functions

- Integrated pilot-wire monitoring. With digital filters, aging problems are avoided
- Operational measured values I_{M1} , I_{M2} , I_{Diff} , I_{Restr}
- Self-supervision of the relay
- Event logging
- Fault logging
- Oscillographic fault recording (differential current included)

Communication interfaces

- System interface
 - IEC 60870-5-103 protocol or DIGSI 3 for remote access
